Year 5 will be playing their brass instruments and our KS2 choir will be singing.

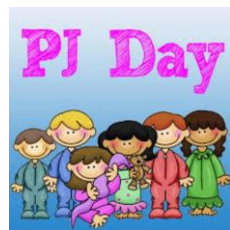
Book Bags
