Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the summer term.

The topic for the first half of term will be 'On the Farm' and the attached topic map gives further details. We are hoping to book a trip to Willows Farm; this gives the children firsthand experience of being on a farm and seeing the different animals. The farm has informed us they are unable to take any bookings until the 17<sup>th</sup> May - we will let you know immediately, if we are successful in securing a visit. The topic for the second half of term will be 'Under the Sea' and the topic map will be sent out nearer the time.

Home Learning

We will continue to use Seesaw, on Friday, I post a review of the week, this gives you an idea of what the children have been learning and this term there will be activities to complete at home, along with a recording of the book we have been using. If you have any questions, you can always use seesaw to send me a message.

We will resume sending two books home each week, book bags must be returned on Thursday and new books will be taken home on Friday.

I know some families are concerned about the use of hand-sanitizer; it is only used once a day for children as they enter the school, at other points in the day, hands are washed with soap and water.

In the event we finally have some sunshine, we ask that sunscreen is applied at the start of the day, it will not be possible to keep sunscreen in school under current COVID guidance, and children will also need sun hats.
