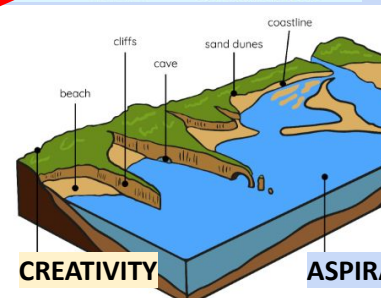

ocean	A very large body of salt water.
coast	The part of the land that is next to the sea.
village	A group of houses and other buildings grouped together to make a community in the countryside. Smaller than a town.
town	A group of houses and other buildings grouped together to make a community
city	A very large group of houses and other buildings grouped together to make a community. Much bigger than a town.
cliff	a large mass of rock that is very tall like a natural wall of rock.
harbour	A place with walls built into the sea to protect boats
island	A body of land that is surrounded by water.
